

# *Clinician CEs at the Faith & OCD Conference*

## How to Earn Credit

All individuals registered with the "Clinician" registration type are eligible for live credit for this event.

Live Credit Requirements: Clinicians must attend each session, complete a session evaluation for each session attended, and complete a full conference evaluation.

## Learning Objectives

Participants will be able to recognize the prevalent symptoms of faith-based OCD. Participants will be able to describe the distinction to their scrupulosity patients that treatment is an OCD issue, rather than a faith-based issue. Participants will be able to develop distinct OCD treatment strategies that incorporate a patient's faith. Participants will be able to communicate to a patient's faith leader helpful and unhelpful strategies in order to avoid patient reassurance.
